Jobs in the Future

The future of work is changing fast. New technologies such as artificial intelligence, robotics and virtual reality are creating jobs that didn't exist a few years ago. Many traditional jobs will disappear, but new and exciting opportunities will appear. Experts believe that cooperation between people and machines will be very important in 2050, because technology will not replace humans completely. Instead, it will help workers do their jobs faster and more safely.

Some jobs will focus on improving life on Earth. For example, climate change will require specialists who protect the environment and design solutions to reduce pollution. We may have "urban farmers" who grow food in tall buildings and on rooftops in large cities, helping the planet by producing vegetables close to where people live. Another important job could be "health data analysts", professionals who study medical information to identify risks and prevent diseases before they appear. These workers will help hospitals offer better treatments and improve people's quality of life.

Other jobs will take people beyond our planet. Space tourism is becoming more popular, so "space travel guides" might help visitors enjoy safe and exciting trips to the Moon or even Mars. There could also be "asteroid miners" who search for rare materials in space to support new technologies on Earth. Engineers, pilots and technicians will all be needed to make space exploration possible.

However, not all future jobs will be high-tech. People will still need teachers, artists, nurses and psychologists, because technology cannot replace human creativity, emotional support or social skills. In fact, empathy, communication and teamwork will be essential qualities in future careers.

All in all, the jobs of the future will offer great possibilities. Young people must be ready to learn new skills throughout their lives and adapt to new challenges. The future is full of opportunities for those who are prepared to grow, collaborate and innovate.

- 1a. Why will urban farmers be important in the future?

Possible answer: Urban farmers will be important because they will grow food in tall buildings and on rooftops, producing vegetables close to where people live and helping the planet.

Justification: The text explains: "We may have 'urban farmers' who grow food in tall buildings and on rooftops in large cities, helping the planet by producing vegetables close to where people live." (par. 2)

- 1b. According to the text, what personal qualities will be important in future careers?

Possible answer: According to the text, empathy, communication and teamwork will be essential personal qualities in future careers.

Justification: The text states: "In fact, empathy, communication and teamwork will be essential qualities in future careers." (par. 4)

- **3.a.** In the future, work will involve...

a) less technology. **X** Incorrect because the text explains that new technologies will play an important role in the future of work.

b) cooperation between humans and machines. Justification: "Experts believe that cooperation between people and machines will be very important in 2050." (par. 1)

c) no new job opportunities. ✗ Incorrect because the text says that new and exciting opportunities will appear.

- 3.b. Who might help people travel to the Moon?

a) Urban farmers ✗ Incorrect because urban farmers will grow food in cities.

b) Space travel guides Justification: "Space travel guides might help visitors enjoy safe and exciting trips to the Moon or even Mars." (par. 3)

c) Health data analysts ✗ Incorrect because health data analysts will study medical information and help prevent diseases.

4. Are the following sentences true or false? Underline the correct option (1 point, 0'5 each)

- 4.a. Space tourism is not mentioned in the text. True / **False, justification: Space tourism is explicitly mentioned in paragraph 3: "Space tourism is becoming more popular."**
- 4.b. Creativity will not be necessary in future jobs. True / **False, justification: The text explains that technology cannot replace human creativity: "People will still need teachers, artists, nurses and psychologists, because technology cannot replace human creativity, emotional support or social skills." (par. 4)**

5. Use of English. Choose the right option: (1 point, 0'25 each sentence)

- In 2050, robots _____ many boring jobs.

a) do ✗ Incorrect because in 2050 refers to the future, so the present simple is not appropriate here.

b) will do "Will do" is correct because the sentence makes a prediction about the future. "Do" is in the present simple and "did" refers to the past.

c) did ✗ Incorrect because *did* refers to the past, not to a future prediction.

- I think I _____ work in a green-energy company.

a) am going to "Am going to" is the only option that correctly expresses a future intention or prediction. "Have to" expresses obligation and "was" is an incomplete past form in this sentence.

b) have to ✗ It expresses obligation, not a future intention or plan.

c)) was ✗ Incorrect because *was* cannot be followed directly by the infinitive work.

- Space tourists _____ special suits during their trips.

a) wear **X** It describes a general fact or habit, but it does not express obligation.

b) must wear "Must wear" is correct because it expresses an obligation or safety requirement. "Wore" is in the past, while "wear" does not express the necessary obligation conveyed by the sentence.

c) wore **X** Incorrect because it is in the past, while the sentence refers to space tourists in general or in the future.

- If we study hard, we _____ more opportunities in the future.

a) is having **X** Incorrect because it does not agree with the subject *we* and it does not follow the first conditional structure.

b) had **X** Incorrect because the main clause of the first conditional requires *will + infinitive*, not the past simple.

c) will have This is a first conditional sentence. Its structure is: *If + present simple, will + infinitive* Therefore, the correct answer is "will have".
