Our planet Earth is a very special one. Our atmosphere has a unique device: a layer of gases that keep the planet warm, and of which CO2 is the main driver for the greenhouse effect. In the past, the Earth's climate changed as a result of natural causes, but since the Nineteenth century human activity has been causing the increase in the temperature of our planet by burning fossil fuels. If current tendencies continue, the effects will be so severe that human civilization might disappear because the rise in global temperature might mean, according to reports: loss of food production, increased flooding due to the melting of icebergs in the poles, and water shortages among others; and as a consequence of all this, poverty, famine, migration, and the spread of infectious diseases. Authorities need to investigate the replacement of oil or coal as major power sources with wind or solar energy, or the one coming from the tides of the seas. At present, global warming does not happen by default. It is a man-made problem, a global issue; and there is an obligation on us all to take action. If action is not immediately taken, the change in nature will have serious impact on people and economics.
